



## Volunteer Commitment Agreement



Team Up 4 Orphans (“TU4O”) is a program of Doma International (DI). As a TU4O volunteer, you will help DI or a DI partner organization raise funds for children involved in the programs of DI or DI partnering organizations.

DI asks a lot of its TU4O volunteers. First, we ask you to commit to train for and participate in a half marathon. We also ask you to participate in program-related and organizational activities held before and at the site of the event. This may include media events, meetings with local officials, TU4O workshops, and submitting a profile for our website.

As a TU4O volunteer, you will receive no compensation from DI. You will be asked to raise a minimum amount for the children to help defray the costs of the TU4O program. If you raise the minimum level of funds, you will be eligible to have your expenses of participating in the marathon paid for by DI.

In light of this, we take your commitment to raise the fundraising minimum seriously. We want all TU4O volunteers to be successful in raising at least the minimum and have structured the program to provide the support to help you reach this goal.

The suggested fundraising goal for the 2010 Capital City Half Marathon in Columbus, Ohio is \$2500 (\$4000 per married couple registering at the same time). However, the fundraising minimum is set at \$500 to ensure we keep our program costs low, maintain credibility to all of our donors, and maximize the funds we are able to invest in our mission to help orphaned and vulnerable children. If you will be traveling from outside of Columbus, your fundraising minimum is \$500 plus the actual cost of your airfare/transportation to/in and hotel in Columbus.

While we understand that this may be the most money you have ever attempted to raise, and you may feel unsure about whether you will be able to do it, if you follow the recommended guidelines and use the materials provided, you will be successful.

We ask that by February 28, 2010, the recommitment date, you reaffirm your commitment to the team and your commitment to raise the fundraising minimum for TU4O. You will need to have raised at least \$500 of the fundraising goal by this date in order to recommit. If you have not raised at least \$500, you will be responsible for covering these costs associated with your participation in order to continue.

We ask that by April 15, 2010, the confirmation date, you will have all of your funds raised. If the minimum is not raised, you will need to secure your position on the team with a credit card or check for the difference between funds raised and the fundraising minimum, which will be non-tax deductible. You may be reimbursed for this money if more funds come in to you up to and until May 15, 2010. At this time, whatever money was given by you to secure this fundraising goal may then be considered tax deductible and will be considered a DI donation.
